REFUND POLICY

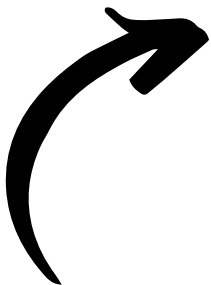
Refunds are not issued unless the activity is cancelled or changed by the City. Participants will be notified and a full refund will be processed within 2-4 weeks.

LAGUNA BEACH HS & COMMUNITY POOL



The LBHS & Community Pool is a 25-yard pool with showers and day-use lockers available. It is accessible to individuals who are physically challenged. Please note that California state law requires patrons who use public pools to shower prior to entering the water. Young children must wear swim diapers or rubber pants in the pool. Adults are required to accompany and supervise children under the age of 12, and must stay within arm's reach of any child who cannot yet swim independently.

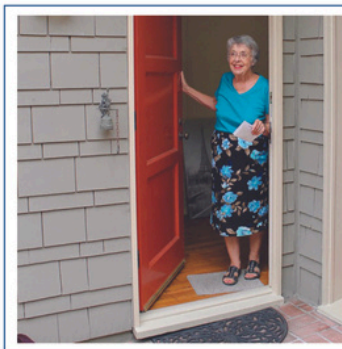
